
Saturday - Obedience Entries are limited to 8 hours of judging per judge.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

**ENTRY FEES:** Regular Classes - \$30 per entry and \$27 for each additional entry for the same dog (includes the \$50 AKC recording and \$3.00 event fees for each entry). Brace and Rally Novice Pairs: \$18 total. Veterans: \$18. RACH class: \$63.

Entries will not be accepted if received without fees. All Recording Fees are to be paid to the American Kennel Club. This trial is open to dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program. Rally and Obedience are separate trials so one entry in each counts as 2 first entries.

**Entry Limits:** Obedience - Saturday: Limited to 8 hours of judging for each judge. Obedience - Sunday: Obedience Classes Limited to 7 hours of judging for Mrs. King and 3 hours for Ms. Chase. Rally - limited to 3 hours of judging.

Closing time for entries is 6 PM, February 13, 2019 after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted. Move Ups will be allowed as set forth in the AKC Regulations. Open and Utility in jump height order, high to low. Baby gates between rings. Rally entries in jump height order, high to low, Rally Ring: 40' x 40'.

Errors on entry blanks are the owner's responsibility. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date. Telegraph, telephone, unsigned entries will not be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entry fee shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified or excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Show Committee. A refund, less \$5.00, will be made for bitches that come into season after the closing date of the trial, provided request is made in writing accompanied by a Veterinarian's certificate and received no later than the day of the trial.

Acknowledgements of entries will be made after the closing date. If acknowledgement is not received within a reasonable time after the closing date, notify the Trial Secretary at (401) 333-1701 or sproxie@yahoo.com. Confirmations will be sent via email unless otherwise requested.

Show Hours: 8 AM - 5 PM. See Judging Program for judging times. All dogs should arrive 15 minutes before judging time. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahua (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
